Greetings, everyone! See page 3 for the registration form for the "2024 Quad State Rally" this August near Lanesboro, MN. Please print it out, fill out the form, and then mail that form along with your check to Joan Winkelman at the address found at the bottom of the form.

On page 4 you'll find a screenshot of the campground map. Way over on the east side you'll see "tent" sites E2-E10 in purple. E5-E10 have no water and no electrical. However, E2 and E3 have electrical. (E4 is already taken.) So we have available to us. E2, E3, and E5-E10. Again, this is for tents only. If four of our tenters need electrical hookup, then they can share E2 and E3. If more than 4 tenters need electrical, then we have an issue.

Melanie said that there is a water spigot near the showers/laundry area. She said that it's a walk, but not bad. If need be, Julia and I can bring jugs of fresh water for coffee. There will be picnic tables available for us in our area. So I'm guessing that serving breakfast somewhere near the tent area will work out just fine. There is a sheltered picnic area south of the tent sites. Just not too sure how far away it is or if it will be available to us. Melanie said it's a crap shoot as to who gets it and when. Please note!

- 1. If you're a tenter, please contact the campground before April 8th to secure your tent site. For tenters that will need electric, sites E2 and E3 are the only two available. (Two tents can share one site.) If you do NOT need electrical hookup, then please choose tent sites E5-E10.
- 2. If you plan on staying at the campground with a trailer, please contact the campground as soon as possible to secure a site near the Heartland Sundae Road Riders tent area. Being close to the tenters is NOT guaranteed.
- 3. Just so everyone knows, I'm currently locking in tent sites only. I am not reserving sites for those members showing up with campers. People camping with campers will need to reserve their own sites nearby.

I grabbed these particular tent sites because they're really close to the bathrooms and showers.






